

2010 TAX ABATEMENTS  
Or Tax Relieve.

ALL ABATEMENTS MUST BE APPLIED FOR EACH YEAR.

File abatements with the Davis County Clerk/Auditor Department Room 107 from  
January 1 thru December 31 of each year.

TO RECEIVE AN ABATEMENT YOU MUST OWN THE PROPERTY AS OF  
**JANUARY 1**  
OF THE CURRENT YEAR.

BLIND - \$11,500 in taxable value. First time filing a statement from an ophthalmologist is required. The Blind abatement may be used on real property, mobile homes and/or personal property (vehicles).

DISABLED VETERAN'S – Must have a service connected disability rating from the Veteran's Administrative of 10% or more. Each 10% is \$22,893 in taxable value or approximately \$250.00 per each 10%. There is no income limitation. Each year the county requires a current VA-Letter (A Tax Abatement Letter or Summary of Benefits Letter) with an effective date of January 1 of current year. The Veteran abatement can be used on real property, mobile homes and/or personal property (vehicles).

CIRCUIT BREAKER – Must be 66 years of age or older or a widow/widower. If a widow/widower must have a death certificate first time filing. Total gross household income for 2009 must be \$28,785 or less. (Income limits change each year). The Circuit Breaker Abatement amount applied is based on a sliding scale. The Circuit Breaker Abatement can be used on real property or mobile homes *not on personal property*.

INDIGENT – Must be under 66 years of age and not a widow/widower. Total gross household income for 2009 must be \$28,785 or less. (Income limits change each year.) Indigent Abatement will pay  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the total taxes up to \$853.00. The application requires a current doctor's statement of disability or an affidavit or circumstances. The Indigent Abatement can be used on real property or mobile homes *but not on personal property*.

Everyone must provide there own support. (meaning can not be claimed on anyone else taxes as a dependent)

Abatement can only be applied to your primary residence.

**What is the Blind Abatement?**

Any person declared legally blind by a license ophthalmologist is eligible for the blind abatement.

**What is the Circuit Breaker Abatement?**

The Circuit Breaker program provides general property tax relief to low income taxpayers who have “income” below statutorily mandated levels. Must be 66 years of age or older, or a Widow /Widower.

**What is the Disability and Indigent Abatement?**

The Disability and Indigent abatement program provides general property tax relief to low income taxpayers who are under the age of 66 that have an: Extreme Hardship, or Disability.
