A New Headquarters

On October 13, 2012, the new Headquarters Library opened in Farmington, replacing the original library built in 1964. The new library was designed as an integrated part of the new Administrative Building for Davis County. The Headquarters Library is 19,000 square feet, with approximately 10,000 square feet dedicated to public space; the remainder is used for administrative offices and technical services that support the operation of the entire library system. Public service space includes adult, children's and young adult collections. It also includes seating areas, quiet study space, two conference rooms, "pop out" seating areas for leisure reading, Internet workstations and a 100-seat auditorium. The Administrative Building, including the library, is designed for energy efficiency. Heating and air conditioning use a ground-source heat pump system and landscaping is based on low-water use plantings. The collection on opening day was approximately 77,000 items with room to grow to nearly 100,000. Space for small story times and a colorful children-at-play window highlight the children's room. The building includes an outside courtyard, benches, a stone fountain and a drive-up book drop. The public was welcomed into the buildings with a morning ceremony, comments from County Commissioners, tours and story times. Located near the Farmington City Hall and recreation area, the new Headquarters Library is now - and will be far into the future - a vital presence in the civic heart of the city and Davis County. It will remain dedicated to serving the needs of the community and individuals in the spirit of free inquiry in the information-rich world of the 21st Century.

Highlights

The Library's summer reading program featured an Art Extravaganza, Invention Convention, jugglers, Mad Science, magicians, Scales and Tails Utah, Airplane "Fun"amentals with Eric Bell and other programs that helped children "Dream Big", & "Read!" Programs offered for teenagers included the Babysitting Boot Camp, Duct Tape Creations, A Positive U and a GPS scavenger hunt. Adult programs included authors Matthew Bowman and Charity Shumway and audio book narrator, George Guidall.

By the Numbers

Over 168,000 registered library users borrowed just over 2.8 million items in 2012. The Library website had around 1,051,000 hits during the year. As the Library began to expand its eBook holdings, there were 55,500 check-outs of eBooks and downloadable audio books. Access to the Internet was a big draw, with nearly 30,000 sessions on Library PCs and over 400,000 sessions on the Library's wireless network.

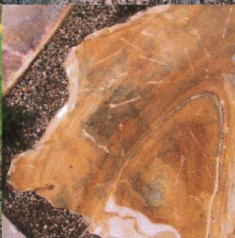
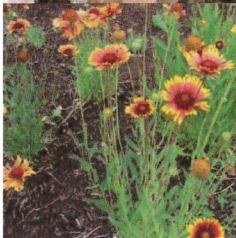
