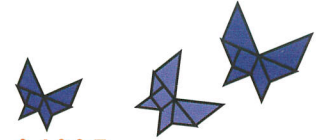
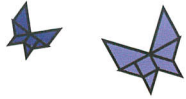
## Our Year in Review

**New Kaysville Branch Library opens** – The new Kaysville Branch opened with a flourish on August 15, 2015. Opening celebrations included a ribbon cutting ceremony, guided tours, storytelling, train rides, balloons, and concluded with a performance by the Davis High School Marching Band! This new 15,000 square foot facility includes an auditorium that comfortably seats 180, two conference rooms, dedicated quiet study space, 13 internet PCs and reproductions of LeConte Stewart's paintings and drawings. A focal point in the new library is a wall of unique and colorful tangrams that serve as an engaging backdrop for the children's area. With an increase in usage of 20-25% over the previous year, the citizens of Davis County, particularly the Kaysville community, have discovered and embraced this new library.

**Programs** – 2015 was a busy year for programming. Throughout the year a variety of programs were offered for patrons of all age levels. Featured programs included a photography workshop where patrons learned photography tips and hints during a hands-on experience. In continuing the library's long standing effort to host author events for the public, best selling author Shannon Hale spoke at the South Branch in February. In March, the **Seuss on the Loose** program was extremely popular as families attended read-a-thons at the South, North, and Central branches. May saw the return of the ever popular **Babysitting Boot Camp**, offered as a way to prepare young people for babysitting jobs. **Every Hero Has a Story** was the theme for the summer reading program, which offered a full range of activities that promoted reading and the library. In the fall, the annual **Spooktacular** program was well attended at all seven branches. And finally, a holiday puppet show finished out the year at the new Kaysville Branch. Combined attendance for all weekly storytimes and programs was 48,650.

**By the Numbers** – Over 173,000 registered library users borrowed over 2.75 million items in 2015. The library website had around 4.2 million page views by 609,000 users. There were 174,230 checkouts of eBooks and downloadable audio titles, an increase of 45% over the previous year. Free access to the public computers and Internet continues to be popular, with around 372,000 sessions on library PCs and 762,000 sessions on the library's wireless network.

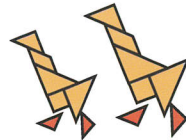
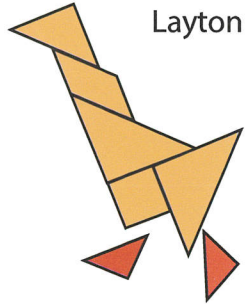
