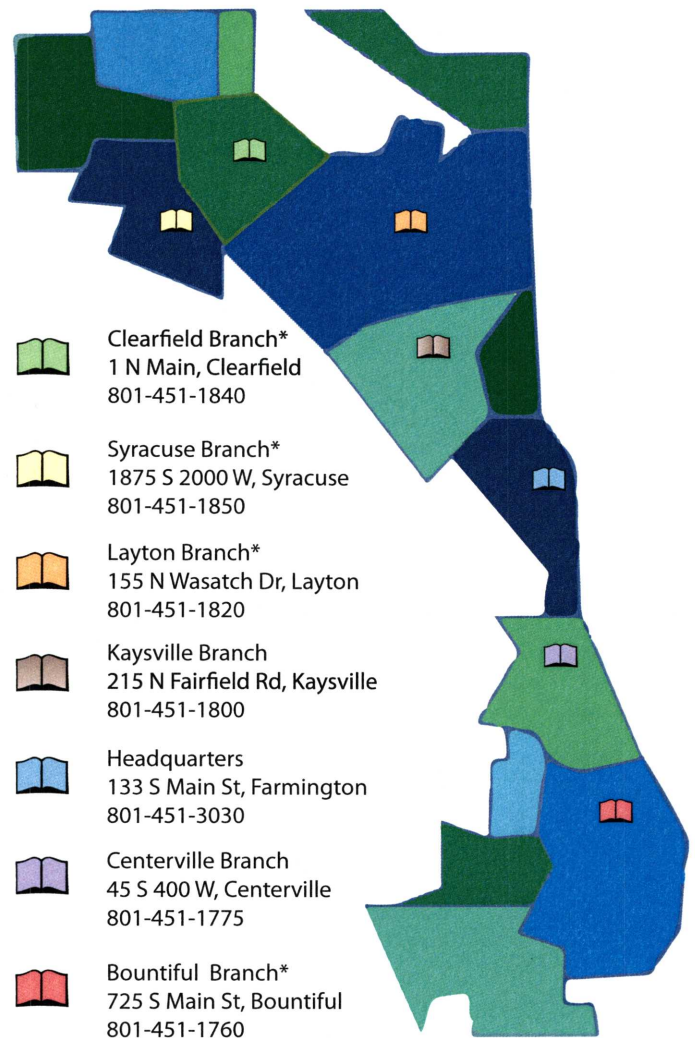

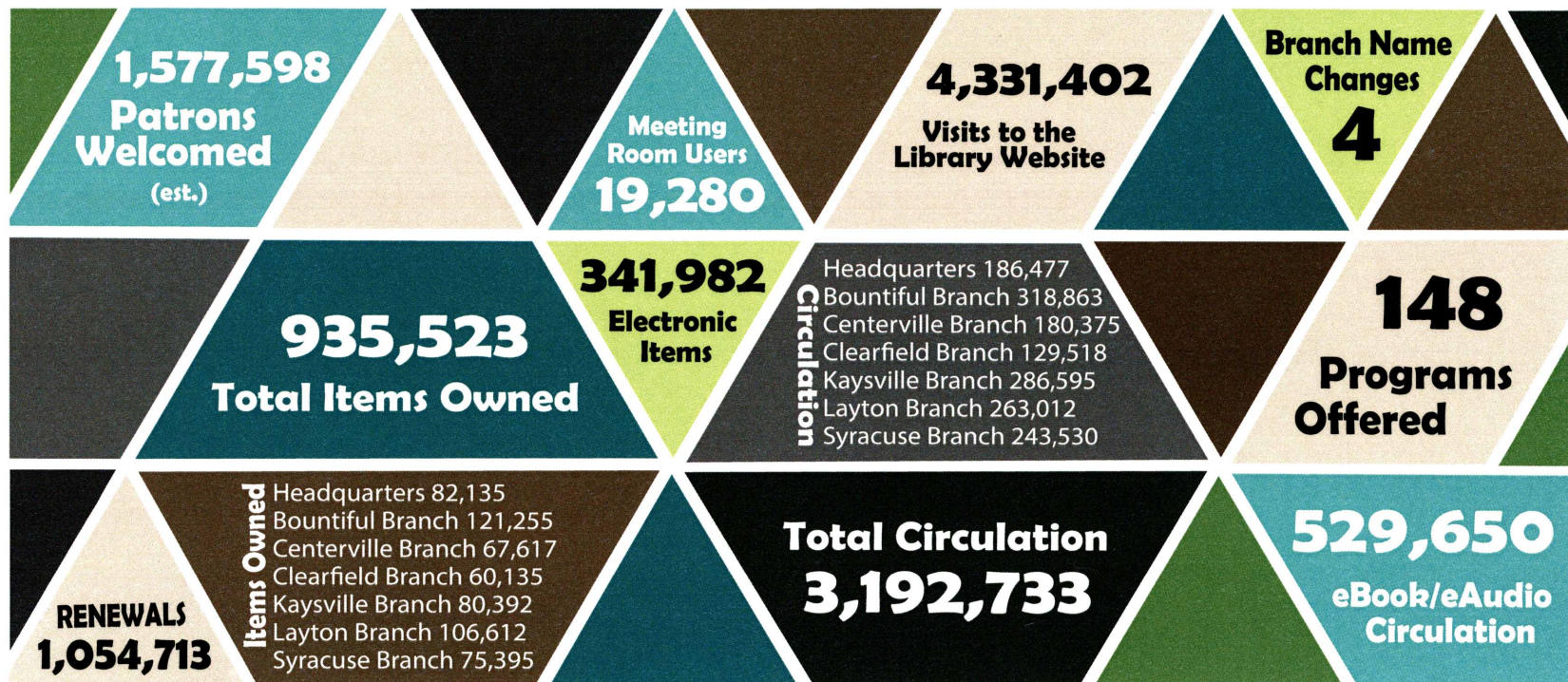

THE YEAR IN REVIEW

The Davis County Library celebrated its 75th year with decorative pins and the sealing of a time capsule. The capsule will be opened in 25 years to celebrate the Library's centennial anniversary. Staff also shared news articles on social media detailing the library's humble beginnings at Davis High School in 1946.

In June, the library welcomed back in-person programming after fifteen months of virtual events. Summer Reading included a mix of live and recorded virtual programs, and was welcomed by an enthusiastic public.

On Saturday, October 23rd, the Clearfield Branch opened in a new location and with a new name. The library at 1 North Main Street replaces the old North Branch Library which was located on the corner of 600 South and 1000 East. The new location is in the middle of a revitalized downtown, close to high density residential, city and county offices, and is more visible to vehicular and pedestrian traffic. The branch offers a blend of traditional library collections along with expanded technology offering additional computers, a small recording studio, a 3D printer, and patron access to Adobe Creative Suite. Covering just under 14,000 square feet on two floors, the new library also offers expanded study and conference spaces, a large meeting room, and expansive views of the Wasatch Front, Antelope Island, and the Great Salt Lake.

The Library changed its Integrated Library System (ILS) in December. The new ILS features a Davis County Library app which allows patrons to place holds and check out items in the library, something that has not been available to patrons previously.
