INCIDENT SUMMARY

Caller reported that a Marathon Petroleum contractor was conducting excavation and dewatering activities to fix an "anomaly" on the pipeline. Caller reported that the trench is deeper than 20 feet and approximately 25-30 vac trucks have gone to and from the site. The contractors are pumping water out of the trench, across the bike path, and into a filter bag that is in a wetland. Caller noticed a sheen on the water in the wetland.
