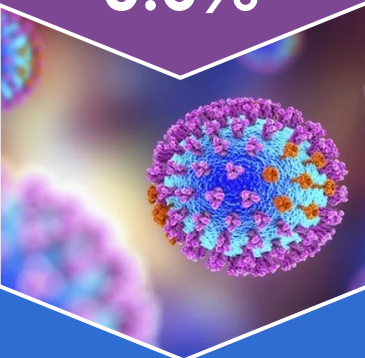

Influenza-like Illness (ILI) is defined as fever (temperature of $\geq 100^{\circ} F$ [$37.8^{\circ} C$]), cough, and/or a sore throat without a known cause other than influenza.

INFLUENZA ACTIVITY IN DAVIS COUNTY

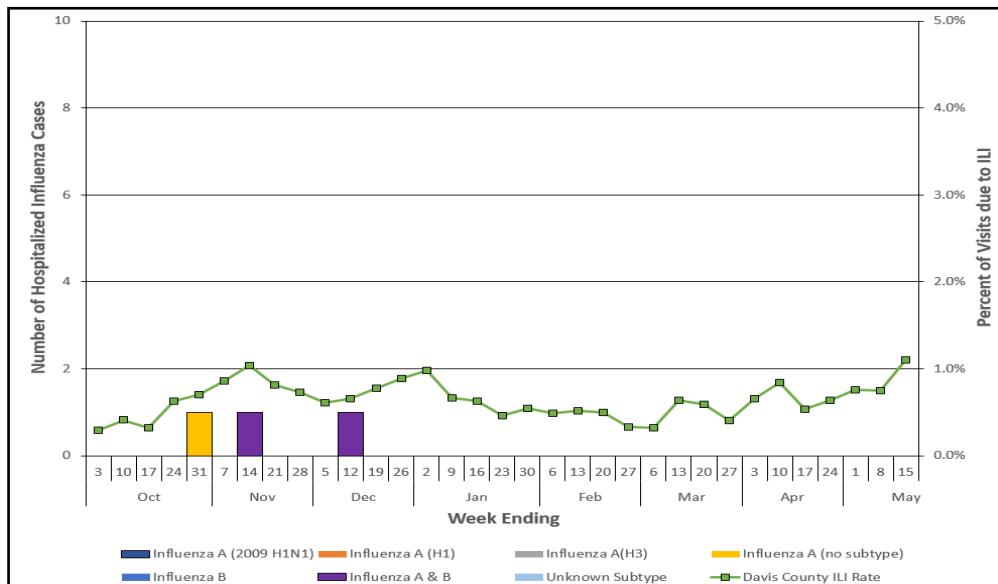


Figure 2. Weekly Influenza Activity Estimates, Week 20 (May 16 - 22, 2021)

Influenza activity in Davis County and Utah remained at a low level throughout the 2020-21 influenza season. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, school absenteeism was not a reliable metric for influenza numbers this season. There were three total influenza-related hospitalizations in Davis County (see Figure 1) and 14 in Utah during the 2020-21 influenza season. Similar trends occurred nationwide (see Figure 2). Davis County will begin conducting traditional influenza surveillance for 2021-22 in October.

Figure 1. Influenza-like-Illness rate and Hospitalized Influenza Cases, by subtype and admission date, Davis County, 2019-20
