Davis County Health Department Announces Closure Date of Legacy Events Center COVID-19 Vaccination Site

DAVIS COUNTY, UTAH – Wednesday, January 26th, 2022, will be the final day the <u>Davis County Health</u> <u>Department</u> (DCHD) operates its drive-thru COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic at the <u>Legacy Events Center</u> in Farmington. With the closure of this clinic, and knowing there is still a need to provide COVID-19 vaccines to our community, DCHD will begin to operate a COVID-19 vaccination clinic at its Bountiful/Woods Cross location (596 West 750 South, Woods Cross) on Tuesday, February 1st, 2022.

Due to a decrease in staffing and size of this new site, appointment availability will be limited at the new Bountiful/Woods Cross location. Days/hours of operation will be Monday-Friday from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, and just like the Legacy Events Center site, appointments will be required and can be scheduled online at: <u>https://go.usa.gov/xAZFD</u>, or by calling (801) 525-4900, Monday – Friday, from 8:30 am to 5:00 pm.

Along with the Bountiful/Woods Cross clinic, DCHD will also operate COVID-19 vaccination outreach clinics at a number of locations throughout Davis County over the next couple of months. Days/hours of those outreach clinics have yet to be announced, but will be posted on the DCHD website, as well as DCHD's social media channels (Facebook/Twitter/Instagram).

"For all those looking to get a COVID-19 vaccine; whether it's a 1st dose, 2nd dose, or a booster dose; the time to seek us out and schedule an appointment is right now!" said Trevor Warner, Communications Manager for the Davis County Health Department. "At this time, the COVID-19 vaccine is the best public health tool we can offer to protect everyone from this dangerous and deadly virus. It is imperative that we get as many people vaccinated and protected as we possibly can!"
