

# NOTICE

The Davis County ***Housing Ordinance Regulating Supplied Facilities, Maintenance and Occupancy of Dwelling and Dwelling Units*** addresses and regulates minimum standards for basic equipment and facilities. That section requires that in order for a water system to be approved by the health authority, the water system must be connected to the dwelling. The Davis County Health Department has adopted regulations entitled requirements for ***Approval of Private Well Water Supplies***, which specifies requirements that a property owner must comply with in order to obtain approval for a private well water supply.

The undersigned is in the process of obtaining a building permit, or has commenced construction and improvements for a residence, or has completed such residential construction or improvements before the granting of approval by the health authority for the water system. The undersigned acknowledges that the requirements established by the Davis County Health Department in the ***Requirements for Approval of Private Well Water Supplies*** must be met before a Certificate of Occupancy can be issued and the residence lawfully occupied and that it is the responsibility of the undersigned to comply with these requirements.
