SSBG Program



“Social Services Block Grant (SSBG) funds furnish social services to meet the needs of the residents of Davis County.”

Funds May Be used for but not limited to programs that provide services to Low and Moderate Individuals who are Davis County residents:

-Services to persons with disabilities, Case management, Health-related services, Medical Transportation, Foster care, Substance abuse, Home-delivered & Congregate Meals, Independent/Transitional living, Employment services or any other Social Services found necessary.

SSBG Program: Goals



Services funded by SSBG Program as far as practicable are directed at one or more of five goals:

- Achieving or maintaining economic self-support to prevent, reduce or eliminate dependency;
- Achieving or maintaining self-sufficiency, including reduction or prevention of dependency;
- Preventing or remedying neglect, abuse or exploitation of children and adults unable to protect their own interest, or preserving, rehabilitating or reuniting families;
- Securing referral or admission for institutional care when other forms of care are not appropriate or providing services to individuals in institutions.

 - July 1, 2020-June 30,2021
- The Next SSBG Grant Application Process will Begin October 2019 with Awards being given in July 2020.
 - Pre-Application Workshop - November
 - Letter of Intent- Due in December
 - Online Application Opens -January 2020
 - Application Review-March
 - Awards- March/April
 - Grantees Awards Approved- June
