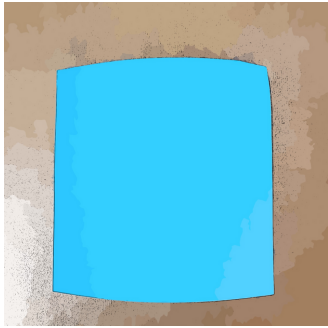
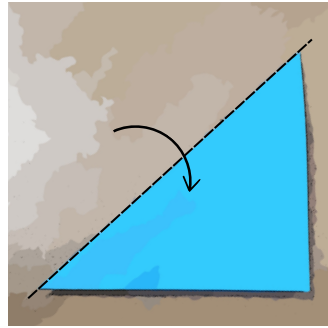


TAKE & MAKE — ORIGAMI BUTTERFLY KIT

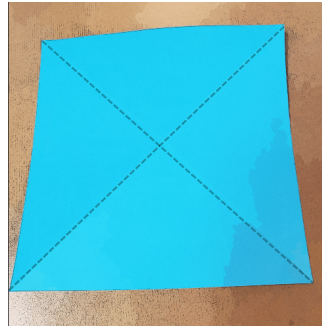
Requires one piece of origami paper



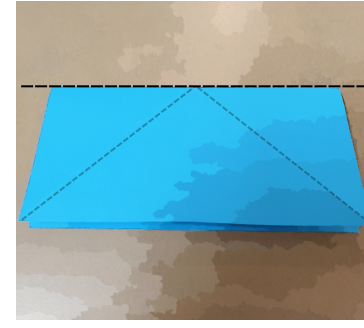
1. Start with a square piece of paper laying face down.



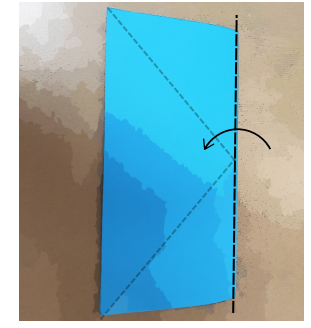
2. Bring the top left corner down to the bottom right, creasing diagonally. Unfold.



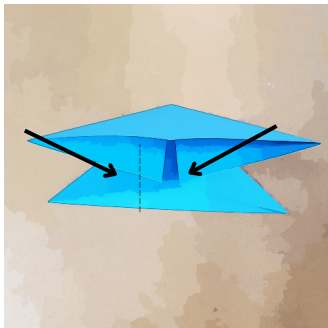
3. Repeat step two on the other side, and unfold, creating an X with the creases.



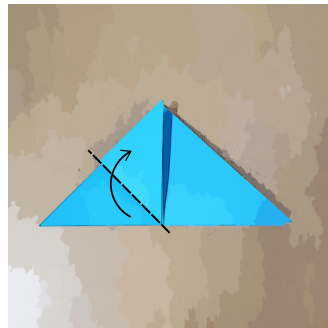
4. Bring the top edge down to the bottom, creasing horizontally. Unfold.



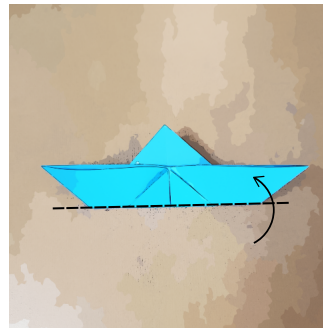
5. Bring the left edge over to the right, creasing vertically. Unfold.



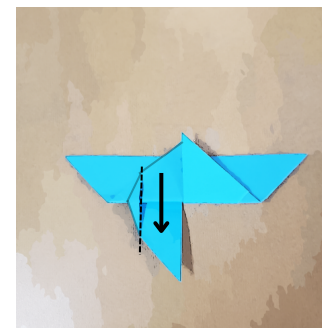
6. Bring the horizontal creases on both sides down to the middle until they touch, collapsing the paper into a triangle shape.



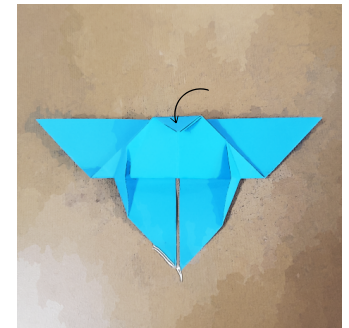
7. Take the front left flap and bring the bottom edge up to the top point of the triangle, creasing it in half. Repeat on the front right flap.



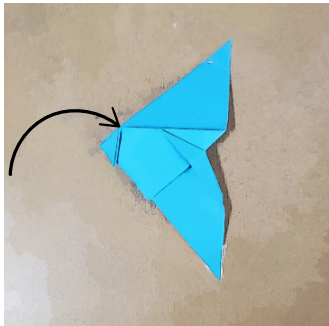
8. Flip the model over. Then, take the bottom and fold it upwards, creasing the model in half horizontally.



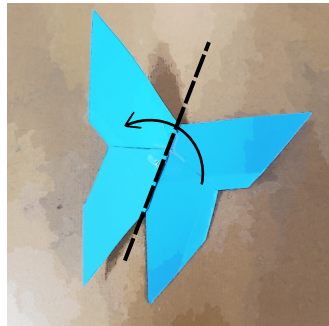
9. Flip the model over again. Next, take the left flap and fold it downward, flattening the left edge into a triangle shape. Repeat on the right flap.



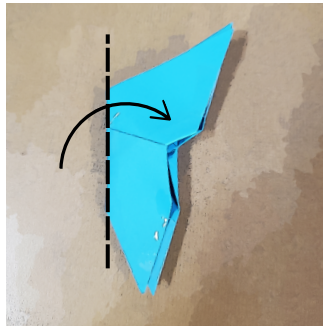
10. Flip the model over. Then, fold the small triangle at the top of the model downwards.



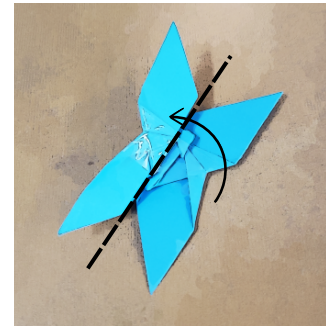
11. Flip the model over, then fold it in half vertically so that each wing tip touches.



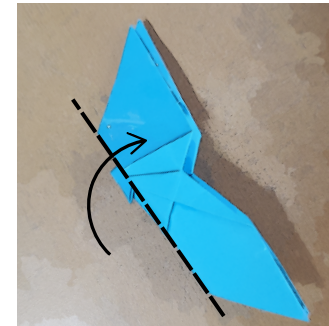
12. Next, hold the model where the bottom wings start, at the star. Take the top flap (the upper wing) and fold it upwards.



13. Flip the model over and repeat step 12.



14. Take the top flap and fold it back, aligning it with the middle section of the model.



15. Flip the model over and repeat step 14.



16. Open the butterfly and place it face up to finish!
