Our Year in Review

Technology - In April we went live with our new Davis County Library website. Representing months of work by Library and Information Services staff, the new website offers an attractive portal to the library's many services, with special emphasis on blog posts promoting the collection, automatically updated cover art of new titles, events, and an expanded section of online resources. At the same time we introduced a DCL presence on Facebook and Twitter, which serve as added ways for patrons to receive news and information about the library. We also added a job hunting component to our ReferenceUSA database as well as adding Morningstar Investment Research Center, which provides detailed information on companies, stocks, and mutual funds.

Programs - We continued to host quality author programs, with appearances by best-selling young adult author Brandon Mull (over 500 attendees in two sessions) and mystery writer Josi Kilpack. We had a full slate of children's programs throughout the year: *Through the Magic Door* (at Central, North, and South branches) with nearly 1,000 in attendance. *Dig Into Reading*, the Summer Reading program, was a huge success with over 13,000 attendees at a wide variety of programs at all seven libraries. The popular *Spooktacular* programs at Halloween provided some family friendly scary stories. *Babysitting Boot Camp* returned once again and was attended by many prospective babysitters.

Coming Soon - In 2013, we selected an architect and began the design process for the new Kaysville Branch Library. Ground was broken for the new branch in June 2014 with a tentative opening date of summer 2015. Our new branch library will be able to house 100,000 items and will include a 180 seat auditorium, expanded internet access, plus conference and study rooms.

By the Numbers - Over 178,000 registered library users borrowed over 2.8 million items in 2013. The Library website had around 951,000 hits during the year. As the Library continued to expand its eBook holdings, there were 86,865 check-outs of eBooks and downloadable audio books, a 56% increase over 2012. Access to the Internet was a big draw, with around 253,000 sessions on Library PCs and over 694,000 sessions on the Library's wireless network.
