# **Our Year in Review**

**Technology** – In October 2014, the library introduced our new Enterprise catalog, which allows our patrons to view, checkout, and download eBooks and downloadable audiobook titles without leaving the catalog. Similar to searching on sites such as Amazon, Enterprise allows our patrons to easily limit searches by format, age level, author, subject and other factors. Previously, our patrons needed to sign-in to the OverDrive or OneClickdigital websites to search and checkout electronic titles; now they can see all the versions of the titles owned, whether in print, audio-visual or electronic formats in one display. Davis County patrons can quickly access over 62,000 eBooks and over 11,500 eAudio titles in addition to nearly 745,000 items held in the branch collections.

**Programs** – In addition to regular weekly storytimes, we offered a wide range of programs throughout the year. In March, nearly 1,000 people attended the "It's All A Mystery" reading event at our Headquarters, Central, South, and North Branches. Our annual Summer Reading program broke attendance records, with nearly 14,500 attendees at the scheduled programs, plus nearly 11,000 attendees at storytimes occurring throughout the summer. In addition, the "Spooktacular" Halloween programs in all branches and the holiday puppet shows at South and North Branches were very well attended. Our annual author event series continued with a visit in July from Jennifer Nielsen, a very popular young adult author.

**Kaysville Construction** – Groundbreaking for the new Kaysville Branch Library occurred in August 2014. Construction continued throughout the winter months due to mild weather. The new building will increase the space available for library service from 6,000 to 15,000 square feet. The ribbon cutting and grand opening for the new library will occur on Saturday, August 15, 2015.

**By the Numbers** – Over 175,000 registered library users borrowed over 2.7 million items in 2014. The library website had nearly 1.3 million hits during the year. As the library continued to expand its eBook holdings, as well as integrating these titles into the new Enterprise catalog, there were 128,625 checkouts of eBooks and downloadable audio titles, an increase of 42% over the previous year. Free access to the public computers and Internet continues to be a big draw, with around 383,000 sessions on library PCs and over 819,000 sessions on the library's wireless network.
