PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

This is notice that Unincorporated Davis County has received a proposal for the creation of an agriculture protection area on 1,132.609 acres of land located in West Davis County at approximately 6000 W. and 2425 N. On Aug. 18th, 2020, the Davis County Commission will hold a public hearing in Rm. 303 of the Davis County Administration Bldg., located at 61 S. Main St. Farmington, UT 84010, beginning at 4:00 PM to discuss and hear public comment on the proposal to create the agriculture protection area. The application is required to appear before the Davis County Agriculture Advisory Protection Board and the Davis County Planning Commission. The Davis County Agriculture Advisory Board met on July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and recommended approval. The Davis County Planning Commission met on August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and recommended approval.

All interested parties are encouraged express their opinion on the matter. Documentation related to the above information is available for review at the Community & Economic Development Office located at 61 S. Main St. Farmington, UT 84010. Due to Covid-19, the public may submit their support or objections in writing to the address listed. Those that choose to attend in person will be required to wear a mask for the entire duration of visit and practice social distancing.
